

Prize Draw 3: November-March cohort

Online Learner Engagement Survey Prize – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by the National Centre for Student Equity in Higher Education, Curtin University of Technology, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 (“NCSEHE-Curtin”).
5. The Online Learner Engagement Survey Prize November-March (“the competition”) commences at 8am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Friday, 31 October 2014 Australian Western Standard Time.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 5pm AWST on Monday, 30 March 2015.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to students who have taken part in the Online Learner Engagement Survey, November 2014 – March 2015.
8. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - (a) be an online student of Curtin University, and must not be a NCSEHE-Curtin staff member or a family member of a NCSEHE-Curtin staff member; and
 - (b) fill in the Online Learner Engagement Survey via the link sent to their Curtin student email address or linked on their course website and submit the survey before the closing time.
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
11. Staff employed by NCSEHE-Curtin and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be one (1) prize. This prize will be an iPad Wi-Fi 16GB.
13. There will be one (1) draw at 2pm Australian Western Standard Time on Tuesday, 31 March 2015 at the National Centre for Student Equity in Higher Education offices at Curtin University. The draw will be by a computer-generated random number which is matched to each eligible student’s entry number; students will be sequentially numbered according to the date and time they finished and submitted the survey.
14. The prize winner will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email address supplied by the entrant on the event registration form.
15. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-one (21) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
16. If a prize winner who has been contacted and is made aware of their prize winning does not collect the prize within twenty-one (21) days of this contact, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
17. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner’s parent or legal guardian.

18. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, must provide photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport when collecting the prize.
19. The prize winner will be responsible for all costs associated with collecting and using the prize.
20. By entering the competition the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.

23. The prize winner's name and photograph may be published on the Curtin website. By entering the competition, entrants grant Curtin permission to use their full name and course of study on its website for up to six months from the date of the draw.
