Remote Student University Success: An Analysis of Policy and Practice

This Fellowship brings policymakers and practitioners together to investigate how the sector and Australian Government, Department of Education and Training can effectively support students to overcome the barriers impeding university success. It examines best practice examples from across the sector to help define principles of good practice and explores how government policy can be informed to enhance the support of students.

A sector-wide scan of existing datasets will also be completed to formulate a comprehensive profile of remote students at university.

The findings of the Fellowship will be informed by a study exchange to Canada with two Associate Fellows and a secondment to the Department of Education and Training.

This Fellowship will address a neglected area of research to deliver positive outcomes for remote students, their communities and all who support access, participation and success for university students across Australia.
